The Clock Tower Schools' Prison Rape Elimination Report: January 1st, 2023-December 31st, 2023

Since its inception in 2021, The Clock Tower Schools has embraced the principles associated with the Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003. The Clock Tower Schools has taken steps toward the prevention of sexual abuse at the school. In 2023, Clock Tower Schools continued in the development of its program in a way that demonstrates the importance it places in preserving the safety of all individuals.

The Clock Tower Schools continues to address the prevention of sexual abuse, and in 2023 the organization provided PREA training for all staff. In addition, The Clock Tower Schools expanded its use of cameras by ensuring they were placed in all areas around campus that students have access. While doing so, the privacy and sexual safety of future students were taken into account. We have also entered into a memorandum of understanding with the Delaware County Victim Assistance Center to provide students with an additional external reporting resource, as well as necessary victim advocate support.

In 2022 and 2023, The Clock Tower Schools did not provide services to students. Therefore, the reports for both 2022 and 2023 document zero incidents.

The Clock Tower Schools realizes that it must maintain its efforts to prevent incidents and avoid them at all cost. The school will continue to maintain a healthy environment by conveying a zero-tolerance policy with regard to all types of abuse, to staff, and students. Results of investigations will be used to determine if changes are needed at The Clock Tower Schools, which would include but not be limited to, policies, procedures, staffing, personnel assignments, and supervision.
