Botvin Lifeskills®

Botvin LifeSkills® Training enhances skills in decision-making, communication, and managing emotions. This life skills problem-solving method aims to prevent "at risk" behaviors by targeting the major social and psychological factors that precede the actual action. Facilitated discussion, structured group discussion, and role-playing scenarios are used to stimulate participation and promote the acquisition of skills.



Moral Reconation Therapy®

MRT® is a cognitive-behavioral counseling program that is designed to reduce anti-social behavior by developing moral reasoning skills in the areas of:

- · Reinforcement of positive behaviors and habits
- · Enhancement of self-concept
- · Development of frustration tolerance
- Development of higher stages of moral reasoning and others



Coping With Anger®

Coping With Anger supports juveniles who have problems with appropriately managing feelings of anger and frustration. The program is designed for group sessions focused on teaching and practicing anger management skills.



Parenting & Family Values®

Parenting and Family Values is designed to help students develop parenting skills and assess values related to family issues and relationships. Students confront their parenting skills and habits, clarify their family values, and establish appropriate discipline routines.

Drug and Alcohol Education

Substance abuse plays a role in juvenile delinquency. Drug and alcohol education through Foundation for a Drug-Free World aims to educate youth as a preventative measure. The goal is for participants to become more responsible and productive members of society when they leave The Clock Tower Schools.



Gun Violence Prevention®

In recent years, gun violence has increased at alarming rates. Gun Violence Prevention provides youth with practice in making meaningful choices while noting the impact of gun violence on individual, family, communal and societal levels. The program is based on the Gun Violence Prevention Workbook compiled by the Department of Public Welfare's Bureau of Juvenile Justice



Independent Living Skills®

Independent Living Skills assesses the behaviors and competencies that youth need to achieve their long-term goals, and be successful in 25 areas. By developing the independent living skills needed to be successful after placement, students are more likely to experience a smoother return to their community. The program is based on the Casey Life Skills® curriculum.



Victim Awareness

Victim Awareness aims to increase awareness not only of a crime's impact on the victim, but on the community as a whole. The Victim Awareness program utilizes an approved curriculum developed at the Center for Juvenile Justice Training and Research (CJTRR) at Shippensburg University.


